

WHAT IS A MICRO-GROUP?

In its simplest form, a **Micro-Group** is a relational group of 3 to 6 Life Group members who individually pursue spiritual transformation and who relationally commit to honesty and vulnerability. (Proverbs 27:17 - “As iron sharpens iron, so one man sharpens another.”)

Micro-Groups regularly engage in “life-on-life” experiences including: mutual self-examination, reading the Bible consistently, prayer, exhortation, serving together, and being in regular communication with one another. Because of this, they allow for deeper sharing, support, and accountability. Members of Micro-Groups are invited and challenged to take courageous steps in their discipleship journey and experience Holy Spirit transformation.

Micro-Groups are typically sub-groups of a Life Group, and they are an optional part of the Life Group experience and require a higher level of commitment.
